the following Deed was recorded August 24, 1866.

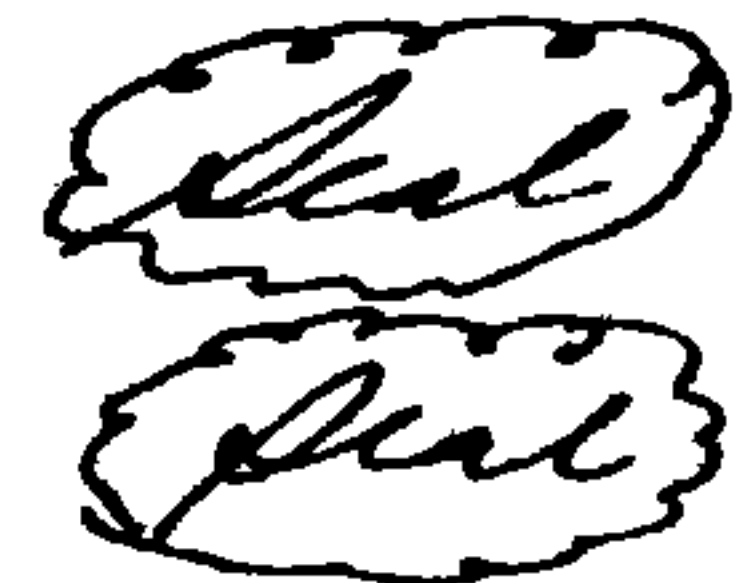

This Deed, made this thirtieth day of April, in the year Eighteen hundred
and sixty six by us John T. Peddicord and Sarah A. his wife. Witnesses that
in consideration of the sum of ten dollars, the said John T. Peddicord and
Sarah A. his wife do grant unto Thomas O'Jord all that part of a tract
of land lying and being in Frederick County and State of Maryland
and on the Mountain road leading from Emmittsburg to Mechanics town
and beginning for said part at a stone near the said road, which is also
the beginning stone of the Plat Survey for Abraham Lee by William Moorey
in 1848 and running thence with the first line of said survey northerly
South thirty four and a half degrees West six and eight tenths perches
to a pile of stones, thence North fifty two degrees West thirty two perches
to a stump and stones near a run, thence North sixty seven degrees East
thirteen and fifty two hundredths perches to a pile of stones being the end of
the line of said Moorey's survey, thence South twelve degrees East
four perches with Moorey's line to stone, thence South seventy eight
degrees West two perches to a stone, thence South forty seven and a
half degrees East sixteen perches to a stone, thence South fifty three
and three quarter degrees East seven and eight hundredths perches
to the beginning. Containing One acre, one rood and twenty nine perches of
land in fee simple
