

Trustee Report
of Sales

Conditional for the faithful performance of the trust imposed in them by this Decree or which may be imposed in them by any future order or decree in the premises. They shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real estate having first given at least three weeks previous notice inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notices as they may think proper of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, which terms shall be as follows. - One half of the purchased money to be paid in cash on the day of sale or on the ratification thereof by the Court, the residue in six months from the day of sale or all cash at the option of the purchaser, the purchaser or purchasers giving his, her or their notes with approved security and bearing interest from the day of sale; and as soon as may be convenient after any such sale or sales, the said Trustees shall return to this Court a full and particular account of the same with an affidavit of the truth thereof, and of the proceeds of such sale or sales annexed, and on the ratification of such sale or sales by the Court, and on payment of the whole purchased money and not before, the said Trustees by a good and sufficient deed to be executed and acknowledged agreeably to law, shall convey to the purchaser or purchasers of the said property and to his, her or their heirs, the property which, her or them sold; free, clear and discharged of all claims of the parties to this case, and of any person or persons claiming by, from or under them - and the said Trustees shall bring into this Court the money arising on such sale or sales, and the bonds or notes which may be taken for the same, to be disposed of under the direction of this Court, after deducting therefrom the costs of this suit, and such commission to the said Trustees as the Court shall think proper to allow, on consideration of the skill, attention and fidelity wherewith they shall appear to have discharged their trust.
