

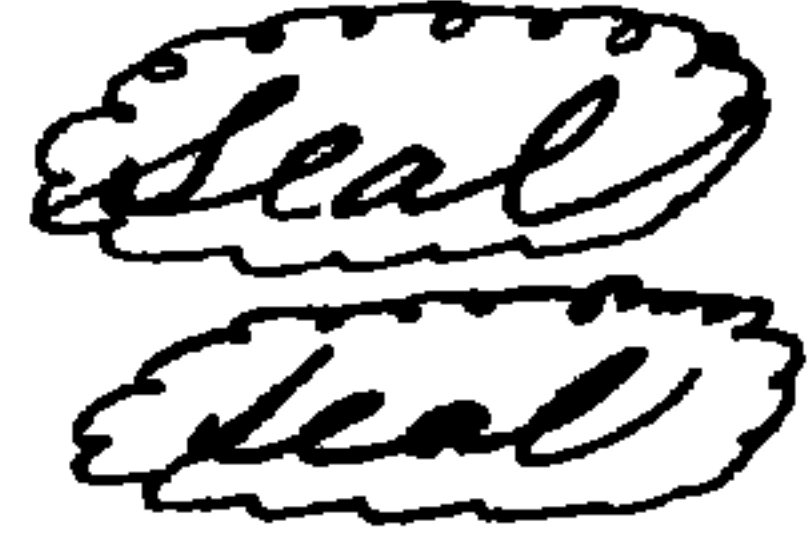

This Indenture made this sixth day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty one by William P. Maulsby Jr of the one part and John J. Cuyam of the other part both of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Whereas by a deed of Trust from George R. Dennis and wife, the above named William P. Maulsby Jr was appointed Trustee with authority to sell the real estate mentioned in said deed among which was the land hereinafter conveyed, and whereas said Trustee sold the land hereinafter conveyed to John J. Cuyam at and for the gross sum of six thousand and twenty dollars payable 1/3 cash, 1/3 in one year and 1/3 in two years from day of sale, and whereas said sale was duly reported to and finally ratified by the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity as will fully appear by the proceedings in the case No. 4424 upon the Docket of said Court, and whereas said John J.
