of your Trustee will have to be resorted to for the payment of said debts. That the claims against said estate and mostly interest-bearing claims, which the funds in the hands of your Trustee are lying at bank, without interest, and it will be greatly to the interest and advantage of said Estate, that the said trust fund be applied to the discharge of said debts, in so far as the same will extend, in advance of the account of the Executor, in the Orphan Court of Frederick County.

And your petitioner prays your Honor to pass an order referring the above cause to the Auditor, to state an account and that the Trustee be allowed for counsel fees, usual Chancery Commission and for all Expenses of sale for which vouchers are produced.
