That said Trustee having been offered by one Edward Hobbs the sum of sixteen dollars (\$16⁰⁰) per acre, at private sale, which offer said Trustee considered a fair price for said land, and as much or more that could be reasonably expected at public sale, said Trustee accepted the same and made sale thereof without offering said land for sale at public sale.
3. That said Edward Hobbs has duly obligated himself to pay said sum of money per acre for said land, as shown by the Memorandum of purchase filed herewith as Exhibit No. 1.
4. That the gross amount of sales is two hundred and forty seven dollars (\$247⁰⁰)
