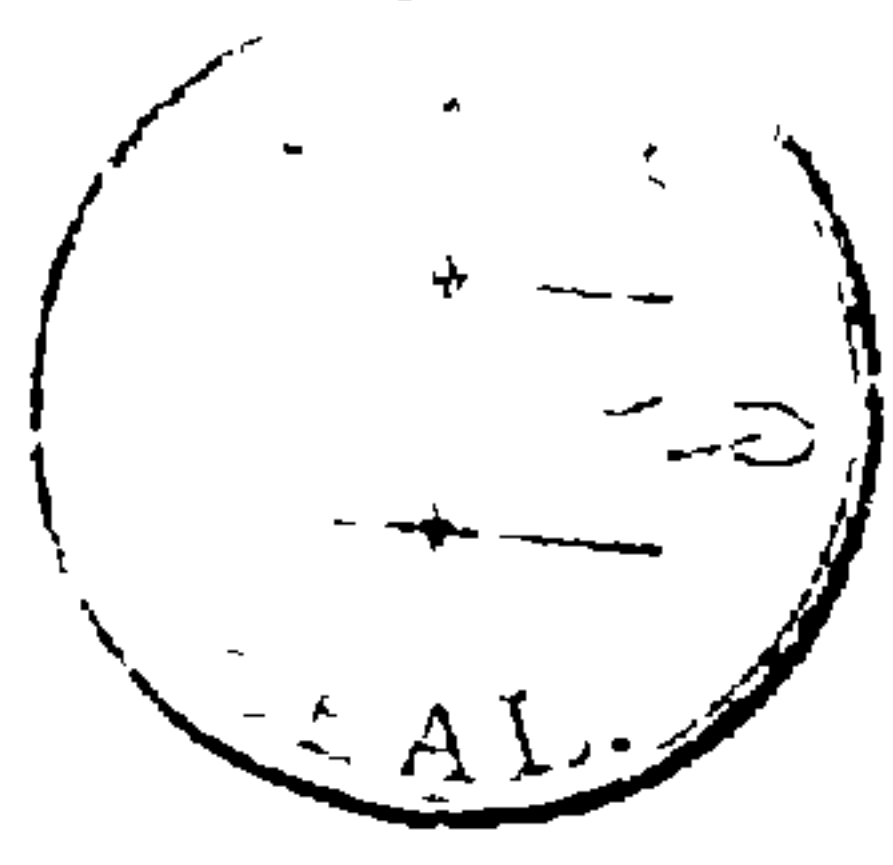

At the request of George W. Etyler the following Deed was recorded April 10, 1876.

This Deed made this first day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and seventy six by us William G. Norris and Ann M. Norris his wife and Elizabeth G. Norris (Mortgage) of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of four thousand six hundred and thirty three and three fourths dollars (\$4633 3/4) we the said William G. Norris and Ann M. Norris his wife and Elizabeth G. Norris do grant unto George W. Etyler of said County & State the following described parcel of land situate lying and being in Frederick County Maryland, it being part of a tract of land called "Warfield's Lot." Beginning for said part at the beginning of the whole tract and running thence North 41 1/2 degrees East 31 perches to a stone North 21 1/2 degrees East 32 perches to a stone North 10 degrees West 32 perches to a stone South 77 3/4 degrees East 27 1/4 perches to a walnut tree North 7 1/2 degrees East 25 perches to a stone North 21 1/2 degrees West 12 perches to a stone North 26 3/4 degrees West 30 perches to a stone North 17 1/2 degrees West 36 perches to a stone North 7 1/2 degrees East 15 3/4 perches to a stone North 35 1/2 degrees East 9 5/10 perches to a stone South 4 3/4 degrees East 9 5/10 perches to a stone South 39 1/2 degrees East 6 3/10 perches to a stone South 10 1/2 degrees East 19 1/2 perches to a marked white oak tree South 46 1/4 degrees West 24 perches to a stone South 39 degrees East 45 1/2 perches to the 27th line of the whole tract then with the outlines South 80 degrees West 60 perches to a stone South 53 degrees West 6 1/4 perches to a stone then North 38 1/2 degrees West 135 perches to the beginning. Containing one hundred and fifteen and three fourths acres and fifteen perches of land more or less in fee simple being the same land which the said William G. Norris obtained from Nicholas H. Metcalf and wife by deed dated on the 23rd day of August 1867 and recorded in Liber D.S.B. No. 2 folio 26, one of the Land Records of Frederick County. And we the said William G. Norris and Ann M. Norris his wife and Elizabeth G. Norris (Mortgage) do Covenant that we will warrant and forever defend the property hereby conveyed against the lawful claims of all persons.

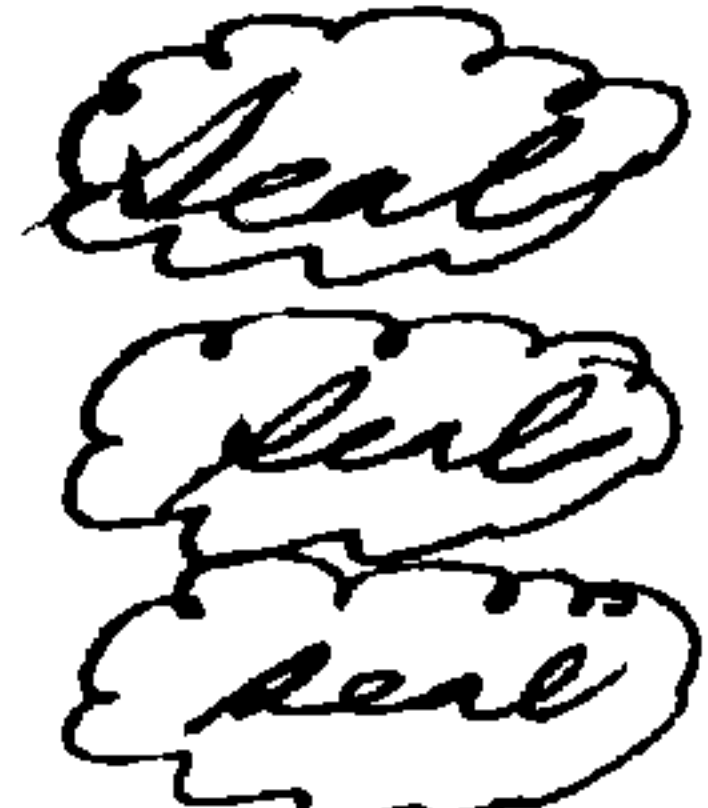
