Jeremiah W. Eyles a witness of lawful age produced on the part
of the plaintiff being duly sworn and examined depose and says
as follows

1st Int. What is your name, age and place of residence?

Ans. Jeremiah W. Eyles, 29 years, Ironville District in Frederick County.

2^d Int. Did you know George W. Eyles late of Frederick County?
If so, is he living or dead - if dead, when and where did he die and
did he die testate or intestate?

Ans. I knew him, he was my father. He is dead. He died in Frederick
County in March 1886 and he died without a will.

3^d Int. Did said George W. Eyles die leaving a widow now living?
If yes, give her name, age and residence?

Ans. He did leave a widow, who is now living. Her name is
Margaret C. Eyles, aged 55 years and she lives in Frederick County.

4th Int. Did said George W. Eyles leave any children or other
heirs at law? If yes give their names, ages and residences
and the same facts of their husbands or wives if any?

Ans. He did. He left five children as his only heirs at law viz -

1. A son Jeremiah W. Eyles (present witness) whose wife's name is Fannie C.

2. A son Anderson W. Eyles whose wife's name is Ida M.

3. A daughter Harriet V. Eyles, who is unmarried

4. A daughter Mrs B. Devilbiss the wife of David M. Devilbiss

5. A daughter Alice May Eyles and unmarried infant. All of the above
children and their husbands and wives reside in Frederick County
and all are adults except Alice May.

5th Int. Did said George W. Eyles die seized and possessed of any real estate?

If yes describe the same, give its quantity and value and where situated?

Ans. He did die seized and possessed of real estate. It is situated in
Frederick County. It consists of two farms one of which has a
