a daughter Catharine E. Russell, a son named John Russell, a son named Lewis R. Russell, a daughter named Marilla, who is married to Eugene Norris.

3. Your oratrix further represents that all of the above named persons are adults and reside in Frederick County Maryland with the exception of Catharine E. Russell who is a non resident of the State of Maryland and whose residence is unknown to your oratrix, and whether she be living or dead and if dead, whether she left any heirs at law surviving her is unknown to your oratrix.

4. Your oratrix further represents and charges that the said Anthony Russell at the time of his death, was indebted unto your oratrix on a judgment duly rendered by James M. Standing a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in and for Frederick County in the sum of Eighty dollars debt and fifty cents costs, which judgment was rendered on the 17th of Feb. 1871, and that it is still due and unpaid - a copy of which judgment and the note on which it is based are herewith filed as Exhibits 2 & 3.

5. That said Anthony Russell died insolvent as to his personal estate and your oratrix represents and charges that her said debt should be paid out of the above mentioned real estate.

6. Your oratrix further represents and charges that the above mentioned real estate is not susceptible of division among the above mentioned parties without great loss and damage. That it would be to their interest to have the same sold and the proceeds thereof divided among them after the payment of your oratrix judgment, but that said parties cannot agree to a sale.

To the end therefore that your oratrix may not be remediless, she prays for the following relief -

1. That a decree may be passed for a sale of said real estate under the direction of your Honorable Court and for a division of the proceeds of such sale among the said parties entitled thereto according to their interests after the payment of the above mentioned indebtedness to your oratrix.

2. That subpoenas may issue directed to the said Henry Russell and Elizabeth Russell his wife, Dennis Sobley and Eliza Ann Sobley his wife John Russell, Lewis R. Russell Eugene Norris and Marilla Norris his wife and Matilda Russell all of Frederick County Maryland commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and show cause if any they have why the relief prayed for should not be granted and abide by such decree as may be passed therein.

3. That an order of publication be issued, requiring Catharine E. Russell of the substance and object of this bill and requiring her to be and appear in this Court in person or by attorney on or before a certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and show cause if any she has why the relief prayed for should not be granted and to abide such decree as may be passed.

4. And that your oratrix may have such other and further relief as she may be entitled to. And as in duty bound to
