This Deed, made this 27th day of June, in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty nine by Thomas H. Hobbs, Isabella N. Crawford of Frederick County, Md., Samuel Mathias of Carroll Co. Md., Jesse Mathias, John H. Mathias of Montgomery County Md., Bennetta E. Hanner and Mortimer S. Hanner her husband of Washington County Md., Thomas H. Barber and Callie Barber his wife of Baltimore City and Warner M. Mathias of Frederick County Md. Witnesseth that in consideration of One dollar the said parties above named do grant unto Deborah E. Hobbs of Frederick County Maryland the following described property land in Howard's District of the said County of Frederick Md. adjoining the Prospect Meeting House Lot being a tract of land which was conveyed to Philip H. Hobbs now deceased by Lewis Crawford and Isabella Crawford his wife by deed bearing date of October 30th 1865, and recorded in Lib. J. M. C. C. Md. 3. folio 272 and of the Land Records of Frederick County Md. Beginning at a stone which is the beginning of the said land bought by Anthony Kemmel and running, viz - No. 1. North Eighty five & half degrees West one hundred and fifty seven and thirteen twentieths perches to a stone south of a large Cherry tree which is the beginning of the closing line of fifty acres of land sold by Anthony Kemmel to Jacob Cochran, the said line being on the East of the Old Annapolis Road, No. 2.
