Frederick W. Ordeman as hereinafter directed, share and share alike:

3. To my son Daniel J. Ordeman I give one sixth.

4. To my daughter Mary Catharine Price I give one sixth.

5. To my daughter Emma Cornelia Hughes I give one sixth.

6. To my son Daniel J. Ordeman I give one sixth in trust that he shall have the same, together with the portion hereinbefore bequeathed to him in trust from my daughter Georgiana's share, for the use and benefit of my son Frederick W. Ordeman during his life, and upon the death of my son Frederick W. Ordeman, then I will and direct that all of said trust fund or estate shall be equally divided among my children John W. Ordeman, Daniel J. Ordeman, Mary Catharine Price and Emma Cornelia Hughes, share and share alike, free and clear of any claim of dower of the present wife of my son Frederick W. Ordeman. It being my intention and I do so will and direct, that the said wife of my son Frederick W. shall have no part or portion of my estate, whether or any portion of that hereinbefore devised and bequeathed in trust for the use and benefit of my said son Frederick W. Ordeman.

And I do further will and direct, that upon the death of the present wife of my said son Frederick W. Ordeman and in case he shall survive her, the said trusts for his benefit shall cease and that portion of my Estate hereinbefore devised and bequeathed in trust for the benefit of said Frederick W. shall be paid and delivered over to him to be his absolutely.

Whereas my husband Herman D. Ordeman has executed his last will and testament whereby he has bequeathed and devised his property to me, now in case my said husband should die before my death, whereby I should become possessed of his Estate under his said will, I do will and direct, that my son Daniel J. Ordeman shall take and hold in trust the Grounds and lots in Baltimore City in and upon Tige lots of ground with improvements situated in said City and which shall constitute a part of the one sixth share hereinbefore devised and bequeathed to him in trust for the use and benefit of my daughter Georgiana, the same to be valued at the sum of thirty three hundred dollars being the aggregate amount paid for them by my said husband. I also will and direct that each of my children shall be charged with the amounts they may severally owe their father, my husband, the said Herman D. Ordeman, at the time of his death and which shall be deducted from their respective portions, but my son John W. shall not be charged with interest on one thousand dollars borrowed by his father, although he shall be charged with the principal as well as with all other indebtedness to his father or to me.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear husband Herman D. Ordeman to be the executor of this my last will and testament, and in case he should die before I do, I then appoint my son Daniel J. Ordeman to be the executor of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills by me heretofore made & ratifying & confirming this & none other to be my last Will and Testament.
