2^d. To my son Daniel J. Ordeman, I give one sixth, in trust, that he shall hold the same for the use and benefit of my daughter Georgianna Ordeman with authority, to invest and reinvest the same to the best advantage for my said daughter Georgianna, and pay over to her or expend for her, and the rents, interest or dividends, receivable from the same as she shall require. And upon the death of my said daughter, Georgianna I then will and direct, that the said one sixth herebefore bequeathed, in trust for her use, shall be equally divided between my children John H. Ordeman, Daniel J. Ordeman, Mary Catharine Price, Emma Cornelia Hughes and Daniel J. Ordeman, in trust for the use and benefit of my son Frederick A. Ordeman as hereinafter directed, share and share alike.

3^d. To my son Daniel J. Ordeman I give one sixth.

4th. To my daughter Mary Catharine Price, I give one sixth.

5th. To my daughter Emma Cornelia Hughes I give one sixth.

6^d. To my son Daniel J. Ordeman I give one sixth, in trust that he shall hold the same, together with the portion herebefore bequeathed to him in trust from my daughter Georgianna's share, for the use and benefit of my son Frederick A. Ordeman, during his life, and upon the death of my son Frederick A. Ordeman, then I will and direct that all of said trust fund or estate shall be equally divided among my children J. H. Ordeman, Daniel J. Ordeman, Mary Catharine Price and Emma Cornelia Hughes, share and share alike, free and clear of any claim of dower of the present wife of my son Frederick A. Ordeman, it being my intention and I do so will and direct, that the said wife of my son Frederick A., shall have no part or portion of my estate, whatever, nor any portion of that herebefore devised and bequeathed, in trust for the use and benefit of my said son Frederick A. Ordeman. And I do further will and direct that upon the death of the present wife of my son Frederick A. Ordeman and in case he shall survive her, then the said trusts for his benefit, shall cease and that portion of my estate herebefore devised and bequeathed in trust for the benefit of said Frederick A. shall be paid and delivered over to him, to be his absolutely.

I give, devise and bequeath to my son Daniel J. Ordeman in trust, the grounds rents I own in Baltimore City, in and upon five lots of ground with improvements situated in said City and which shall constitute a part of the one sixth share herebefore devised and bequeathed to him in trust for the use and benefit of my daughter Georgianna, the same to be valued at the sum of thirty three hundred dollars, being the aggregate amount paid for them by me.

I will and direct that each of my children shall be charged with the amounts they may severally owe me at the time of my death and which shall be deducted from their respective portions, but my son John H. shall not be charged with interest on one thousand dollars heretofore advanced him, although he shall be charged with the principle as well as with all other indebtedness to me.

I will and direct that my son Daniel J. Ordeman, shall have my interest in the property situated on the corner of Patrick and Market Streets in Frederick City, described in a deed to me from John E. Price and
