This Deed made this 27. day of January in the year Eight hundred and Eighty two by us John E. Price and Mollie C. Price his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of six thousand dollars, we the said John E. Price and Mollie C. Price his wife do grant in fee simple unto Capt. Herman D. Ordeman the unity or one undivided half interest in that House and Lot of ground lying and being on the South West corner of Market and Patrick Streets in Frederick City in Frederick County in the State of Maryland, it being the same property which was conveyed by Ephraim Albough to Benjamin F. Stewart and John E. Price as tenants in common by deed dated on the third day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty six and recorded in Liber J. G. No. 6. folio 162. one of the Land Records of Frederick County, the said Benjamin F. Stewart having conveyed all his interest in said real estate to said John E. Price by deed dated the 10. day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty two, and recorded in Liber A. J. No. 4. folio 262. one of the Land Records of Frederick County.
