Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars, we the said Wellington Hammond and Mary E. Hammond his wife do grant in fee simple unto Frederick Correll and Catharine Correll his wife of said County and State, all that lot or parcel of ground, with the buildings and improvements thereon situated, lying and being in Plummers part of Maryland New Market, in the County of Frederick and State of Maryland, and on the north side of the Main Street, it being Lot Number One; having a front of twenty four feet, more or less, and extending back one hundred and sixty five feet for depth thereof, and being the same property and premises which the said Wellington Hammond obtained from Isaac Russell and wife and others by deed recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County in Liber C. M. No. 6. folio 514 re, as by reference thereto will appear.
