created, including reasonable commissions and a reasonable Counsel fee for all services rendered said Trustee by preparing Reports or otherwise and the costs of these presents then to keep the trust fund invested safely and to apply the interest thereof and whatsoever portion of the principal is necessary and reasonable from time to time, in the discretion of said Trustee to the maintenance and comfortable support of and the said Eliza Young during my natural life, and at my death to pay all my funeral Expenses, including a tomb stone and the remainder to pay over in Equal sums to my children William H. Young, Eliza S. Seidel, Crawford F. Young, Caroline V. Atwell, George S. Young, the children of Henry K. Young deceased, and the children of Henrietta Alexander deceased, the child or children of Henry K. Young to take only a child's share and the children of said Henrietta Alexander to take in the aggregate only a child's share, charging as advancements heretofore made to my son William H. Young, one hundred dollars, to my son Crawford F. Young, one hundred dollars, to my daughter Caroline V. Atwell, one hundred dollars, and to my daughter Eliza S. Seidel one hundred dollars, and I further appoint said George S. Young my attorney in my name or otherwise to do all acts, requisite to be done in the premises as fully as I the said Eliza Young might or could have done if these presents had not been executed, and I the said Eliza Young do covenant, that I, my heirs, Executor and administrators will at all times hereafter ratify and confirm whatsoever the said George S. Young shall lawfully do in the premises and will not revoke any of the powers hereby given, nor release, nor compound for any of the debts hereby assigned or sums of money hereby assigned, nor intermeddle with the same nor do anything whereby the recovery thereof shall be hindered, nor otherwise act or interfere in the premises, and that said Trustee shall be charged with his receipts, payments, acts and wilful defaults only -

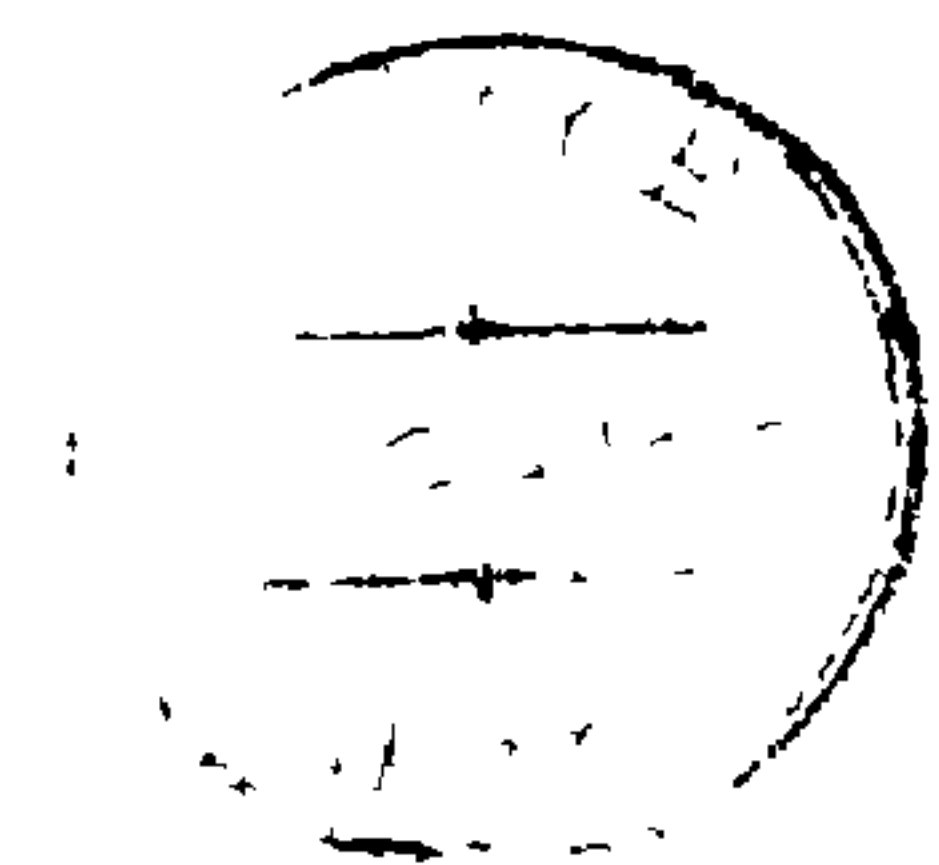
