The Report of John A. Parrick, Trustee, respectfully shows

1. That George H. Clark of Frederick County, State of Maryland, being indebted to various persons in various amounts, did in conjunction with his wife, Nettie Clark, on the sixth day of July, 1887, execute unto John A. Parrick of Frederick County, Maryland, a deed of trust of all his property and estate, both real and personal, for the benefit of his creditors.
2. That after the execution of the said deed of trust the said John A. Parrick gave bond in the sum of three thousand dollars current money, for the discharge of his duties as such Trustee which was duly approved and filed in this Court.
