and Elmer B. Woolfson all of whose are infants under the age of 21 years and all reside at Martinsburg West Va. Charles Woolfson in his lifetime bought a lot of ground from the Plaintiff in this case. I look at Exhibit A and that describes the said property. I was the agent of the Plaintiff at that time. He paid \$500 Cash on the property and was, according to the agreement, to execute a mortgage for \$165. but was killed before the deed was delivered and the mortgage executed. I was present at the execution of an agreement to build a house between the said Charles Woolfson and A.C. Patten. I look at Exhibit A to the Answer of Arthur E. Patten and that is the identical agreement. A few days after the execution of said Agreement Mr. Woolfson paid me \$200. which I paid to Patten on account of said agreement. Mr. Woolfson paid me in 2 or 3 amounts, aggregating the \$300. which I paid to Patten in several amounts for all of which payments I have receipts or checks showing the said payments to him, all of which will be produced if required of me.

After the death of Woolfson, Patten completed the house it was nearly finished when he was killed, and I went to see Mrs. and she declined to do anything further towards paying for the house or lot as she did not want to move to Martinsburg and on account of the infancy of her children. Woolfson was a freight Conductor on the Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road and was killed by an accident at Harper Ferry. The property is worth about \$1400. and should bring that at public sale.
