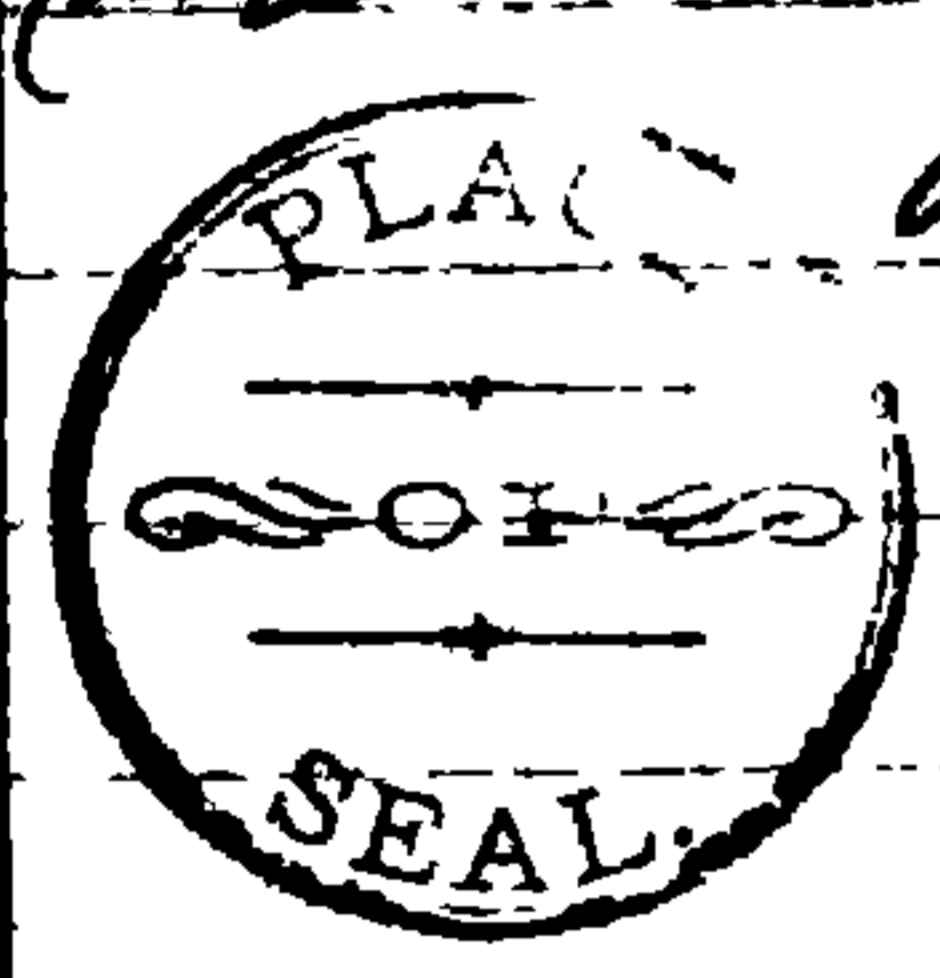

I, Isaac A. Albaugh of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me, hence do therefore make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say:  
First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executrix hereinafter named and devise and bequeath as follows:  
I devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Catharine J. Albaugh my "House and Lot" in Mechanistown and all my Lots of Land and real Estate, during her natural lifetime, and after her decease the same shall be sold under the direction of the Orphans Court, under this my last will and Testament and the proceeds thereof equally divided between my Children then living  
I give and bequeath to my said wife Catharine J. Albaugh all my personal Estate and property of whatever name or nature, with all debts, mortgages, judgments, notes, accounts which are now due me or that may hereafter become due and payable for her own exclusive use and benefit provided she shall pay all my lawful debts and liabilities and funeral expenses and the expenses necessary for settling my Estate, and I do hereby fully empower her to close all mortgages and liens as I could do were
