At the request of John A. Holloway the following Deed is received for Record and Record February 20 - 1885 at 7 O'clock 55 minutes A.M.

This Deed made this Eighth day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty Eight by Thomas P. Mullins and Mollie C. Mullins his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the first part and John A. Holloway of Baltimore City in the State of Maryland of the second part. Witness that in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Thomas P. Mullins and Mollie C. Mullins his wife do grant and convey unto the said John A. Holloway his heirs and assigns in fee simple the following pieces or parcels of tracts of Land called The Resurvey on timber land and part of a tract of land called the Resurvey on "Charles Lot" being part of the same land that was deeded to Lewis F. Detrick by W. R. Dorsey on the 7<sup>th</sup> of June 1878 and Frank Cornell trustee on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1879. Beginning for the outlines to enclose the said parts of tracts of Land in one outline survey at the end of a line across North Eighty three and three fourths west two perches from the base of the Eleventh line of the deed from W. R. Dorsey to Lewis F. Detrick it being in the Centre of the South end of a Culvert, thence with the Centre of a County road as now run (1883) North seventeen degrees East fifteen and twenty eight one hundredths perches
