To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:—

The Petition and Report of Sale of Jacob Hooge, Trustee of Samuel Palmer respectfully shows unto your Honors:—

1. That a certain Samuel Palmer of Frederick County on the 14th day of March 1892 by his deed of trust duly executed and recorded and in which his wife, Catherine Palmer, joined for the sole purpose of conveying her potential right of dower in the lands thereby conveyed, upon the condition of receiving such compensation out of the proceeds of sale as should be allowed her in lieu of her said dower right by the Court having jurisdiction in the premises, did grant, convey, assign and bargain and sell unto your Petitioner all of his property and Estate of every kind, nature and description, real and personal (except such property as by the Laws of Maryland is exempt from execution) in trust to sell the same at either public or private sale and to collect whatever was collectable, and to pay from such sales and collections first all Costs, charges and expenses incurred in the execution of said trust, including a Commission of Eight per cent, and then to the payment in full of all debts due and owing by the said Samuel Palmer, without preference or priority, except as allowed by law, and the surplus, if any, to the said Samuel Palmer, all of which will more fully appear by reference to said deed of trust which is herewith filed, and which with all the other exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken and
