This Deed made on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year 1890 by me Math. C. Wilcoxon of Frederick County Maryland - witness that in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars, & the said Math. C. Wilcoxon do grant unto Amanda C. Bell the following house and lot of ground, situate lying and being on the South side of all Saints Street in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland it being a portion of the real Estate of which John Wilcoxon died seized and possessed, and as surveyed by Wm. H. Willoughby, beginning on the South side of all Saints Street at the end of 16 feet and 5/2 inches west from the North west Corner of the Hotel west end building on Lot No 13 of said survey and running thence with said Street North 84 1/2 west 19 feet and 6 inches, then South 7 1/2 west 10 1/2 feet and 10 inches to a stone fence on the North side of Lewis Burnett's lot and with it South 84 1/2 East 10 feet and 5 inches to the South west Corner of Lot No 5 on said survey and with said Lot North 7 1/2 East 33 feet to a stake, then South 84 1/2 East 8 feet and 7 inches to a stake, then North 6 East 18 feet and 10 inches to a mark on a foot stone, then South 84 1/2 East 9 inches then through and with the outside of the Frame building attached North 9 East 28 feet and 8 inches to the South wall of the Brick Building attached then North 84 1/2 west 9 inches to the middle of said Brick Building then through and with the outside of said Building North 9 East 26 feet and 4 inches to the place of beginning which survey is filed in No 4868 Equity in the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity, by reference whereunto it will fully appear.
