Part of those parts of tracts of land called "Shinn's" and "Cold Friday" which were conveyed to Thomas W. Horn by Daniel Hartsock by Deed dated the 12th day of May - A. D. 1877 and which are particularly described by metes and bounds, courses and distances in the Deed from M. G. Whner, Milton Carter and Wm. P. Maulsby Jr. trustees conveying the same to said Hartsock which last mentioned Deed bears date the 11th day of May - A. D. 1877

beginning at the end of the third line of the Deed from Thomas W. Horn to Emeline Black dated the 9th day of May - 1879 it being also at the end of 36 perches on the 3rd line of the Deed from said Daniel Hartsock to said Thomas W. This indenture made this twenty second day of January in the year of our Lord 1845 between Isaac Brown & Singleton W. Horn who were appointed Trustees by John Horn and his wife Charlotte of Howard County in the State of Maryland, to sell their personal & real Estate for the benefit of their creditors by deed bearing date 20th of March in the year of our Lord 1843 of the one part and Thomas W. Horn of the County and State of Maryland of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Isaac Brown and Singleton W. Horn aforementioned trustees did agreeable to their Authority vested by said deed from
