This Indenture made this twenty second day of January in the year of our Lord 1845 between Isaac Brown and Singleton W. Horn who were appointed Trustees by John Horn and wife Charlotte of Frederick County in the State of Maryland to sell their personal and real Estate for the benefit of their Creditors by deed bearing date 20th of March in the year of our Lord 1843. of the one part and Thomas W. Horn of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the other part witnesseth that the said Isaac Brown & Singleton W. Horn aforesaid Trustees did agreeable to their authority vested by said deed from said John Horn and his wife Charlotte Horn make sell and sell to the said Thomas W. Horn the property hereinafter particularly
