Hartsock his wife, Witness that for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred and eleven dollars and forty three Cents the said Daniel Hartsock and Barbara R. Hartsock do grant unto Thomas W. Harn of said County and State all that piece or parcel of land purchased by the said Daniel Hartsock from Wm. P. Marbury & Milton C. Lane and Milton Carter trustees under a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity passed on the tenth day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy seven in the Case of Jacob W. Nailb and wife @ Hugh Cochran and others being N<sup>o</sup> 4176 Equity in said Court said land being described as part of "Shrivera" and "Bala-Sunday" being Division No 2 described in the Report of sale and Exhibits W and J. P. R. filed in the above Case containing one hundred and eleven Acres and a twenty three perches of land more or less for lines and Courses of same reference is had to deed from said trustees to Daniel Hartsock dated the Eleventh day of May Eighteen hundred and seventy seven.
