This Deed made this seventh day of June A.D. One thousand Eight hundred and Eighty two by Henry C. Gaither and Juliet Gaither his wife of Frederick County State of Maryland, with intent, Act in Consideration of the sum of One thousand and twenty eight dollars and forty Cents the said Henry C. Gaither and Juliet C. Gaither with grant unto Thomas W. Horn in fee simple the following described parcel of Land situate lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland, being part of the tract of Land called Point Rockport and conveyed by Deed Book to Henry C. & George Gaither by Deed dated August 15th 1857 and included within the following words and Boundaries Courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at the end of 46 poles on the 11th line of a former Conveyance, being also the end of 46 poles on the 14th line of the Deed from George Gaither and wife to said Henry C. Gaither thence with the sections thereof allowing for variation S 20 1/4° E 40 1/2 poles to a stone N 7 1/2° W 39 poles to a stone then by line of division N 41 1/4° E 36 poles to the Beginning Containing 3 acres 2 Roods 36 of poles of Land more or less
