This Deed made this ninth day of May Eighteen hundred and seventy nine,
by Thomas W. Horn of Frederick County and State of Maryland. Witnesseth that
in consideration of forty five Dollars, the said Thomas W. Horn do give part
unto Caroline Black of the aforesaid County and State the following described
parcel of land lying in woodville Election District Number 18. part of a tract
of land called "Sherrisa" and "Coke Friday" which was conveyed by Daniel
Hartsock by deed to Thomas W. Horn bearing date Eleventh day of May
Eighteen hundred and seventy seven - Beginning at a stone planted in the
middle of the public road at the extreme N.W. Corner of said street and
running South 69° E. nine and a half perches to a stone South 14° W. thirty six
perches to a stone, North 69° W. ten perches to a stone, North 14° E. thirty six
perches to the beginning Containing two acres and twenty four perches of
land.

Deed is recorded June 12th 1879.

This Deed made this twenty second day of May Eighteen hundred and
seventy nine by me, Thomas W. Horn of Frederick County in the
State of Maryland.

Witnesseth that in consideration of One hundred and thirty five Dollars,
the said Thomas W. Horn do grant unto Edward D. Merrill of the
said County and State, all that lot or parcel of ground sit-
uated in Frederick County which is described as follows, Being
part of a tract of land of the Rowney on Coke Friday, Orange
