This Deed made this 11th day of March A.D. one thousand Eight hundred and Eighty two, by Thomas W. Harn of Frederick County and State of Maryland, witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of five dollars the said Thomas W. Harn doth grant unto Perry Caanch of said County and State the following described parcel of land situate lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland beginning at a stone marked A at the end of the third line of the deed from Jane May and wife to said Thomas W. Harn dated December 26th 1851 and running with the outlines thereof South 39 1/2° West 6 1/2 ps to a stone North 5 1/2° West 9.3 ps then by line of division North 18 1/2° East 8-5 ps to intersect the aforesaid third line at the end of 49.15 ps and with it South 44 1/2° East 40.35 ps to the beginning. Containing 1.0000 and 2/3 ps land.
