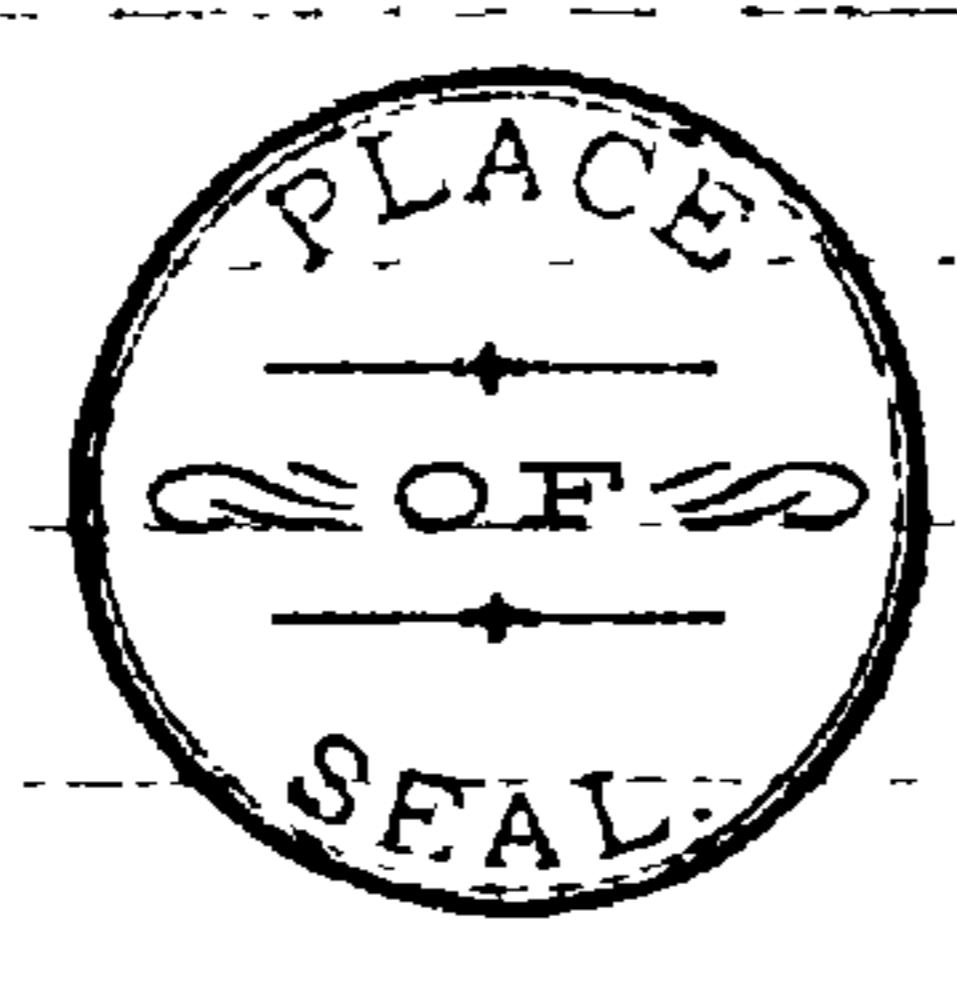

At the request of Mary E. May the following deed is received for Record and Record on Sept 7th 1871 at 12th O'Clock P.M. J. W. Irving Parsons Clerk

This Deed made this second day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy one by one Thomas W. Horn of Frederick County State of Maryland. With intent that in consideration of One hundred and fifty dollars, of the said Thomas W. Horn do grant unto Mary E. May of said County and State the following described parcel of land situate lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland and conveyed to the said Thomas W. Horn by deed from Jesse May and wife and dated December 25th 1857 beginning for the part intended to be conveyed at a stone at the end of the third line of the Deed from the said Thomas W. Horn to Edward O. Mail dated May 22nd 1870 then with said line reversed South 6 1/2° W. 57.65 perches to a stone at the beginning of the second line of the Deed from said Thomas W. Horn to Edward O. Mail dated December 30th 1852 then with said line North 4 3/4° West 35-30 perches to a stone then by lines of division North 4 3/4° East 57.50 perches to a stone South 46° East 53 perches to the beginning containing 15 acres 2 roods 8 sq. perches of land more or less in fee simple.
