In pursuance of the annexed order of the Court and a notice given me by the Solicitor for the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause, J. Clayton O'Keedy one of the regular Examiners of said Court appointed, qualified and sworn, having met at my office in Frederick City, Maryland on the 24th day of March A.D. 1892 and assigned the 30th day of March 1892 at the place aforesaid as the time and place for taking the testimony in said cause and having given me notice thereof to the parties concerned, did at the appointed time and place proceed to take the following testimony to-wit:-

Peter Lugenbeel a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined in the above defined and sworn as follows:-

My name is Peter Lugenbeel, my age 50 years, I reside in Frederick County.

I know all the parties to this suit excepting George W. Harn and wife and William F. Harn and wife. I know their father George W. Harn who was a brother of Thomas W. Harn the decedent mentioned in this case. All the parties to this cause that I am acquainted with are a adult over 21 years of age.

I know Thomas W. Harn, the decedent mentioned in these proceedings late of Frederick County, deceased. He is dead. He died at his residence in this County about Sept. 19, 1891 and left no will. He was a bachelor, never having been married.

Thomas W. Harn died seized and possessed of real Estate in Frederick County, to-wit a tract of about 300 acres of land all lying contiguous except two small lots. It is all situated in Wobawille District in Frederick County and is worth from \$15.00 to \$20.00 per acre.
