1st Q^{ty}. were the terms of the Partnership arranged before the land was bought from Stockdale?

Ans. Yes Sir,

2nd Q^{ty}. The terms of the partnership were that Leonard & you were to have $\frac{1}{3}$ interest each in the profits and each $\frac{1}{3}$ interest in the property and Foreman was to have no interest in the property but $\frac{1}{3}$ interest in the profits. Is that right?

Ans. Yes Sir,

3rd Q^{ty}. I understand you to say that the partnership was formed in 1870. What time in the year?

Ans. In the Spring of the year.

4th Q^{ty}. when did you get possession of the Stockdale property?

Ans. The last of March or 1st of April 1870 as near as I can remember.

5th Q^{ty}. How long after you got possession of the property did you get a check for it?

Ans. I was under the impression that we got it right away because L.R. came down and I gave him \$200.00 to pay for it at once, but it turns out he did not.

6th Q^{ty}. How much were you to give for that property?

Ans. \$400.00.

7th Q^{ty}. How long after that was the Chew property bought?

Ans. The Chew property was bought in August 1870. We paid \$800.00 for it.

8th Q^{ty}. who composed the firm at the time when the Chew property was bought?

Ans. H.C. Cassell was with the firm in the Lumber business at that time; but had no interest in the factory.

9th Q^{ty}. was not the Chew property used in connection with the lumber business?

Ans. Both lots were so used.

10th Q^{ty}. How much money was put into the partnership by Chas. Cassell (Excepted to)

Ans. I do not know.

11th Q^{ty}. was or was not the Chew property paid for by the firm of which Chas. Cassell was a member?

Ans. I don't know. I don't remember now.

12th Q^{ty}. After the purchase of the Stockdale & Chew properties in 1871 & 1872 what buildings were erected by the firm as theirs and at what cost (Excepted to)

Ans. The factory was put up; I don't know the cost of it;

Engine House and Lumber shed, I don't know the cost of them.

13th Q^{ty}. what machinery was placed in and at what cost?

Ans. I can't tell you now. I could if I were home.

I remember one bill was a little over \$1000.00 which we got from C.B. Rogers & Co. The rest I do not remember.

14th Q^{ty}. who first spoke of the dissolution of the partnership?

Ans. I don't remember that any more.

15th Q^{ty}. what induced the dissolution of the partnership?
