This Indenture made this 16th day of August 1849 between Jacob Remburg of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part Alexander H. Gilbert of said State of the other part witnesseth that for & in Consideration of the sum of Ninety nine dollars & 83 1/2 Cents Current money by the said A. H. Gilbert to the said Jacob Remburg in hand paid & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt of which he doth hereby acknowledge the said Jacob Remburg hath bought & sold aliened & enfeoffed & by these presents doth give grant bargain & sell alien enfeoff release Convey and confirm unto the said A. H. Gilbert his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of land called Remburg on part of Georges Discovery situated & lying in Frederick County aforesaid & contained within the following metes & bounds Courses & Distances to wit. Beginning at the beginning of A. H. Gilbert 126 acre perches & runs with the closing line thereof reversed S 88. E 52 1/2 N 1/2 to the end of the 4th line of Lot No. 1 & with it reversed N 2 1/2 E 11 perches then N 76 W 48.9 perches to intersect the 6th line of a tract of land called Chestnut Hollow with said line reversed S 10. W 19.8 perches to the beginning containing 4 Acres 2 rooves & 33 1/2 perches of land more or less. Together with all and singular the buildings improvements appurtenances water Courses rights members privileges advantages & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining & all the estate right title & interest which property claim & demand whatsoever at law & in Equity of him the said Jacob Remburg of in & to the same. To have & to hold the said herein described premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said A. H. Gilbert his heirs & assigns to the only proper use of the said Alex. H. Gilbert his heirs & assigns forever.
