Virginia Bushy, which said will read duly admitted to probate by the Orphans Court of Frederick County, and a letter testamentary thereon issued to the said Virginia Bushy, as will appear by a Certified Copy of said will and letters of administration herewith exhibited marked "B" and that by the terms of said will, the whole estate of the said Christian is now vested in his said widow Virginia

Sixth, that the personal estate of the said Christian A. Bushy is wholly insufficient for the payment of his debts and it will be necessary that the real estate whereof the said Christian A. Bushy, died seized and possessed shall be sold by virtue of a decree of your Honorable Court for the payment of the claims of the creditors of the said Christian A. Bushy, wherefore your Complainant prays for the following relief:

First, that the defendants herein named may answer the matters and things charged in said Bill of Complaint.

Second, that the real estate mentioned and described in these proceedings may be sold under and by virtue of a decree to be passed by your Honorable Court, and that after the payment of the mortgage debt aforesaid which is a prior lien, the surplus remaining may be distributed among the creditors of the said Christian A. Bushy, who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this proceedings, pro rata, without preference or priority, and

Third, that your Complainant may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of his Case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainant the writ of Subpoena against the said Virginia Bushy Executrix of the last will of the said Christian A. Bushy deceased, and against Virginia Bushy widow and sole devisee of said Christian A. Bushy deceased and Charles E. Nail and William P. Miller all of Frederick County, State of Maryland, commanding them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and to abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
