This Deed made this twenty fifth day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and Seventy nine by us Augusta Bushey of Frederick County State of Maryland Thomas F. Bushey and Annie Bushey his wife Worthington H. Panister and Francis V. Panister his wife of the State of Ohio and George F. Gallion and Annie M. M. Gallion his wife of Howard County State of Maryland, Whereas a Certain Jacob M. Bushey late of Frederick County, State of Maryland died in the month of March in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy nine, seized and possessed of Certain real Estate, Situated in said County and State, and which upon his death intestate descended to his Children and heirs at law viz Thomas F. Bushey Annie M. M. Gallion wife of George F. Gallion, Christian A. Bushey and Francis V. now the wife of Worthington H. Panister subject to the dower interest thereof of Augusta Bushey, widow of the said Jacob M. Bushey deceased and whereas the said Augusta Bushey, widow as aforesaid and the said Thomas F. Bushey, Annie M. M. Gallion and Francis V. Panister Children and heirs at law of the said Jacob M. Bushey, with their respective wives and husbands have agreed to sell and convey their respective undivided interest in and to the lands and real Estate which descended to them as aforesaid to Christian A. Bushey of Frederick County, State of Maryland now therefore in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand Dollars paid us by the said Christian A. Bushey according to our respective interest in said lands are the said Augusta Bushey, Thomas F. Bushey and Annie Bushey his wife George F. Gallion and Annie M. M. Gallion his wife Worthington H. Panister and Francis V. Panister his wife do grant in fee simple unto the said Christian A. Bushey all of our respective rights title interest and estate being the interest of the said Augusta Bushey as widow and the undivided interest of the said Thomas F. Bushey, Annie M. M. Gallion and Francis V. Panister as Children and heirs at law of the said Jacob M.
