This Deed made this 23rd day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty six by us Christian A. Bushey and Virginia Bushey his wife of Frederick County State of Maryland, Witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand and four dollars and a fifty four Cents and the said Christian A. Bushey and Virginia Bushey his wife do grant and Convey in fee simple unto George Marshall of said County and State the following described piece or parcel of Land situated lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland, it being part of a tract of land called "Chance Medley" and being also a part of 15 3/4 acres part of said tract of land which was on the 25th day of April 1842 Conveyed to Jacob M. Bushey by Michael Koepf and others and recorded in Liber S. C. No 16 folio 370 & c one of the Land Records of Frederick County and being also described in the deed dated September 5th 1877 from Thomas H. Bushey and others to said Christian A. Bushey recorded in Liber S. C. No 12 folio 304 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Beginning for the part thereof hereby intended to be conveyed at a stone marked R. R. No 2 standing at the end of the 17th line of said deed from Michael Koepf and others to Jacob M. Bushey and said line aware as it now bears North 52 1/2 degrees west 40 perches to a stone formerly planted as one for the beginning of said 17th line then still North 52 1/2 degrees west 67 1/2 perches to the middle of the public Road leading to the line with which then with the middle of said road two courses and distances North 49 1/2 degrees East 60 perches North 37 1/2 degrees East 18 1/2 perches to a point in a line with the westerly line of George Marshall's land then leaving said public road and running with and lying on the easterly side of said George Marshall's land three courses and distances as they now bear South 77 degrees East 32 1/2 perches South 20 1/2 degrees west 57 1/2 perches South 52 1/2 degrees East 106 1/2 perches intersecting D. M. Hammett's land at the end of a stone fence it being the end of the Hammett's line of said Christian A. Bushey's 15 3/4 acre farm then reversing and lying on an arc with the easterly thereof two courses and distances South 12 1/2 degrees west 27 1/2 perches to a stone formerly planted North 66 degrees 50 minutes west 67 1/2 perches to the first mentioned place of beginning containing forty six acres and thirty five and eight tenths square perches of land and the said Christian
