To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

Your Orators Refus A. McLane and Frank C. Norwood, the Trustees appointed by your Honorable Court to make sale of the real Estate in these proceedings mentioned, reporting the sales thereof by them made say, -

Phelps at and for the sum of six thousand and ten Dollars, as shown by the memorandum of the purchase thereof filed herewith as Exhibit B.C.P. to, the said Benjamin C. Phelps, being the highest and best bidder therefor,

4. That the said purchaser, Benjamin C. Phelps elects to pay Cash therefore upon the ratification of the sale by this Court, as will also appear by reference to said Memorandum.

5. That the gross amount of sales is the sum of six thousand and ten dollars (\$610.⁰⁰)
