In pursuance of the annexed order of the Court and notice given me by the solicitor for the plaintiff in the above entitled Cause I, H. Dorey Peterson, one of the regular Examiners of said Court, duly appointed, qualified and sworn, having met at my Office in Frederick City, Maryland, on the 7th day of April A.D. 1893 and assigned the said time and place for taking the testimony in said cause, did at the aforesaid time and place proceed to take the following testimony to wit: - The Plaintiff filed with the Examiners as Evidence Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2, which are herewith returned by said Examiner,

Ann C. Remburg, a witness produced on the part of the plaintiff, of lawful age, being duly sworn and examined deposes and says, My name is Ann C. Remburg, age 67 years and I reside in Frederick County, I am acquainted with all of the parties excepting Albert C. Remburg and Lewis Remburg whom I know of, but not personally. Mr Lewis Remburg who was a brother of mine died intestate on or about January 3rd 1893. He left surviving him a widow Anna C. Remburg, who is an adult residing in Frederick County, and the following heirs at law: a son Eugene L. Remburg an adult unmarried non-resident of this State, residing in North Carolina; a daughter Cora C. now the wife of Charles W. Michael both adults, living in Frederick County; a son Harvey C. Remburg who is unmarried a adult and who resided in the State of California at the time of the filing of the Bill in this Cause but at this time he is here in Frederick County; a daughter Katie B. Remburg an adult unmarried living in Frederick County,
