This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between David Swope of Frederick
County in the State of Maryland, of the one part and John Goshorn Junr. of the
County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witness that the said David Swope
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty seven hundred & fifty dollars
current money to him in hand paid by the said John Goshorn Junr. before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said David Swope doth
hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold, Alien'd, Conveyed, and
Confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, Alien, Convey and
confirm unto the said John Goshorn Junr. his heirs and assigns, all those two
pieces or parcels of Land and premises situate lying and being in the
County and State aforesaid, being part of a tract of Land called "The Newbury
and Turn Style" which was conveyed by a certain Christiana Springer to
Christopher Swope by Deed bearing date the sixth day of May One thousand
Eight hundred, for one hundred and fifty acres, and that part of a tract
of Land called "Six Acres Gained" which was conveyed by a certain
Philip Dice to the said Christopher Swope by Deed bearing date the seventeenth
day of August One thousand Eight hundred and one for twenty one and one
half acres more or less as by reference being had to said Deeds duly acknowl-
eigned and recorded among the Land records of Frederick County
