

No. 6103. Equity.

The following is a plot and description of the farm of which Ann S. Cyle  
late of Frederick County died seized and possessed. The same  
being composed of several pieces or parcels of land and herein re-  
ferred to by the respective deeds of conveyance. First all that tract  
of land conveyed to John Gosham by a certain David Swopa by deed  
dated Oct 30<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1812 recorded in Liber J. P. No 16 folio 790. one of the Land  
Records of Frederick County

Second all that land land conveyed to the said John Gosham by  
Lewis Meddatt by deed dated May 4<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1817 and recorded in  
Liber J. P. No 28 folio 207 & 6 one of the Land Records of Frederick County

Third all that land conveyed to John Gosham by John Blum et al  
by deed dated July 23<sup>rd</sup> A.D. 1825 and recorded in Liber J. P. No  
23 folio 294 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, fourth all that  
land conveyed to Daniel Cyle by John O'Haltz and wife by deed  
dated September 23<sup>rd</sup> A.D. 1865 and recorded in Liber J. P. No 3  
folio 193 one of the Land Records of Frederick County fifth all that land  
conveyed to the said Ann S. Cyle by George J. Marshall and wife by  
deed dated May 4<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1863 and recorded in Liber A. S. No 7 folio 111  
one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Beginning for the same to us include the whole in one entire outline  
survey at a large stone formerly planted and standing in the middle  
of the Public Road leading from the Mechanestown turnpike to the  
Crescentown Road and running thence allowing for variation N 88<sup>th</sup>  
E 903 ps to a stone, N 74<sup>th</sup> E 42 ps to a stone, N 1<sup>st</sup> E 37<sup>th</sup> ps, S 93<sup>th</sup> E 57<sup>th</sup> ps  
to the middle of the Crescentown Road, and with said road S 15<sup>th</sup>  
W 8<sup>th</sup> ps S 20<sup>th</sup> W 90 ps S 1<sup>st</sup> W, 34<sup>th</sup> ps to a large planted stone, thence  
S 5<sup>th</sup> W, 11<sup>th</sup> ps S 7<sup>th</sup> W, 16<sup>th</sup> ps S 27<sup>th</sup> W 4 ps to a stone at the corner  
of John Cromus Lot and with said Lot S 28<sup>th</sup> E, 23<sup>th</sup> ps to a  
stone on the south side of the aforesaid Crescentown Road and  
with it S. 18 W, 26<sup>th</sup> ps thence N 29 W, 28 ps to a stone, thence S 26  
W, 40<sup>th</sup> ps to a stone now made the beginning of that part of said  
farm conveyed and laid off for Samuel Cyle for 3<sup>rd</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> 36 ps  
still by and with the outline of said whole farm S 28<sup>th</sup> E, 38 ps  
to a stone, thence N 87 W, 107 ps to north side of a public road  
and with said road N 20 E 54 ps N 34 E 7 ps to the middle of  
the Mechanestown turnpike aforesaid and with the middle thereof  
N 11<sup>th</sup> W, 25<sup>th</sup> ps thence S 7<sup>th</sup> E 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> ps to the place of beginning,  
Containing exclusively of the 3<sup>rd</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> ps laid off for Samuel  
Cyle, the quantity of 112<sup>th</sup> 0<sup>th</sup> 03<sup>rd</sup>
