Gaver, a son, Laurette, a daughter, who married Charles Kinney, and Clara, a daughter, who married David Ligar, all of whom reside in Frederick County, Md. Elmira, a daughter who married Mahlon Delauter, and Charlotte, a daughter who intermarried with Nathan Caccare, who resides in Washington County, Md. Amanda, a daughter who married Aaron Stottenger, and Mary, a daughter who married James Stottenger, who reside in the State of Illinois, and a John Gaver, a son, who died in September 1855, leaving a widow Jennie Gaver and an infant son John F. Gaver, both of whom live in west Virginia, all of the above named being of full age except the said John F. Gaver, infant.

That the said lands are now held by the above named children and grand child of Caroline Gaver, as tenants in common, subject to the life estate of Peter Gaver as aforesaid and that the same can not be divided among the parties interested without loss and injury.

It is thereupon adjudged and ordered that the complainants by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County, once in each of four successive weeks before the 6th day of October 1892, give notice to the said adult defendants of the object and substance of this Bill and warn them to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 22nd day of October 1892, to answer the premises and show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
