1st To pass a decree or order of this Court ordering said real estate to be sold and the proceeds of sale divided among said heirs at-law as they are respectively entitled to participate therein.

2^d To appoint some suitable person trustee to make such sale and to divide the proceeds as aforesaid.

3^d To take such further order in the premises as to your Honors may seem just.

To the end, therefore, that your Oratrix and Coactors may have the relief to which they are entitled,

May it please your Honors to grant unto them,

1st The writ of Sub-pœna of the State of Maryland, directed to the Sheriff of Baltimore City, against the said Thomas F. Gorsuch and Catherine Gorsuch, his wife, and an order of publication against the said William J. Gorsuch and Catherine Gorsuch, his wife Mabel C. Gorsuch (infant) and Carroll Gorsuch (infant) the non resident defendants aforesaid, commanding them, and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be made as therein prayed, and to grant General relief.

Extract from the last will and Testament of "Polly Johnson."
