Gonsuch and Portuese his wife, live in the City of Baltimore, this State. My information is that the infant defendants Mabel V. Gonsuch and Carroll Gonsuch, live in the State of California.

3rd Int. Are all the parties adults? If not, state which are adults, and which are minors under twenty one years of age?

Ans. All are adults over twenty one years of age, excepting the two children, Mabel V. Gonsuch and Carroll Gonsuch, above named.

4th Int. were you acquainted with the Mrs Sophronia Gonsuch mentioned in the Bill? If yes, state whether she is living or dead, if dead, when and where she died, and whether she died testate or intestate?
