The Bill of Complaint of the Commissioners of Charities and Corrections of Frederick County a Body Corporate respectively show unto your Honors: 1st That your orator is a Body Corporate, duly incorporated under the Laws of Maryland and as such have charge & Control over the Almshouse of Frederick County & the property pertaining thereto, and have under their care and maintenance all persons committed to said Almshouse. 2^d That Among the inmates of said institution as under the Control of your orator is a certain Simon Schmidt who was committed to said Almshouse, called also Montrose Hospital, as an insane person by the Circuit Court for Frederick County on the 12th day of May 1877, as will fully appear by reference to a Certified Copy of the inquisition and judgment of the Court thereon herewith filed & marked Exhibit No 1 —
