3^d That said Simon Schmitt has been at said Montevue Hospital ever since the 15th of May 1911, and is there yet & that during all said time he has been a charge upon the public Authorities of Frederick County, and during the last three years and more he has been supported & maintained exclusively by your Orator, & that neither your orator nor their predecessors have ever received any compensation for the support and maintenance of the said Simon Schmitt.

4th That your orator has recently learned that the said Simon Schmitt is and for a long time has been seized & possessed of a certain piece of real Estate situated on East 2^d St. Frederick City & Frederick County, Maryland, worth about six hundred dollars which was conveyed to the said Simon Schmitt from Charles B. Tippet & wife by deed duly recorded in Liber E. P. No. 9, folio 193 a Certified Copy of which is herewith filed and marked Exhibit No. 2. which is prayed to be taken as a part hereof.

5th That your orator is informed & so charges that said Simon Schmitt has no other means than the real Estate aforesaid to pay for his said maintenance & that he has no committes of his person or estate.

6th That the said Simon Schmitt is indebted unto your orator in the sum of six hundred dollars, for board and attendance while under the care and custody of your Orator, as will appear by a probated account herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 3.

7th That your Orator is informed that it is entitled to be paid for the cost and maintenance of the said Simon Schmitt out of his real Estate aforesaid.

8th That there is considerable amount of taxes due on said real estate and there is no one to collect the rents arising from the said real estate, & to pay the taxes accruing thereon, and said real estate is in danger of being sacrificed for the payment of taxes.

And your orator prays for the following relief.

1st That said real Estate or so much thereof as may be necessary may be decreed to be sold for the payment of the claim of your orator & the other just creditors, if any of the said Simon Schmitt.

2^d That your orator may have such other & further relief as the nature of its case may require.

and for the following process.

1st That the writ of subpoena may issue in the usual form directed to said Simon Schmitt, commanding him to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and to abide by such order or decree as may be passed therein.
