The above cause standing ready for a hearing and being submitted the Bill Answer Exhibits Testimony and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is thereupon this 13<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety-two by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged ordered and decreed, that the same premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that J. Roger M. Sherr and Clayton O. Keedy of Frederick County, be and they hereby appointed trustees to make the said sales and that the course and manner of these proceedings shall be as follows: They shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland executed by them with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of two thousand Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this Decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order or decree in the premises. They shall then proceed to make sale of the said real estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice, inserted in some news paper printed in Frederick County and such other notice as they may think proper of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, which terms shall be as follows. One half of the purchase money to be paid in Cash on the day of sale, or on the ratification thereof by the Court the remainder in six months from the day of sale, or all

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
