Against the proceedings of John J. Gelwick & others.

1st we the undersigned notify all persons and the public in general that we do not owe John J. Gelwick anything

2nd That Daniel Pies & Barbara Pies his wife did not die intestate but devised in their lifetime what was to be done with their property.

3rd That we have paid all legal debts & funeral expenses against the Estate of Daniel Pies & Barbara Pies his wife & therefore will pay none other.

4th That Daniel Arthur Pies has purchased the interest of Mary Ann Elizabeth Potters in the Estate of Daniel Pies & Barbara Pies (deceased) & settled for the same & holds the exclusive Right Title & Interest of the said Mary Ann Elizabeth Potters in said Estate.

5th That we have not jointly or severally obligated ourselves & will not either jointly or severally obligate ourselves to pay any of Mary Ann Elizabeth Potters debts.

6th That Barbara Ann Virginia Heagy has sold her interest in the Estate of Daniel Pies & Barbara Pies (deceased) to Daniel A. Pies & Frederick E. O. Pies but has not received her full recompense yet therefore holds her right until those parties have fully Complied.
