At the request of Catharine C. Hines the following Deed is recorded Oct 16th 1878.

This Deed made this 16th day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy-eight by William A. Wasley of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of One thousand and fifty dollars, the said William A. Wasley doth grant unto Catharine C. Hines of said County and State all the following described parcels of land (being in two parts) viz. For the first part known as lots No 3 & 4 being the same land which the said William A. Wasley obtained from James H. Bryant, Junr. by deed dated 6th day of August 1862 recorded in Liber D. C. No 7 folio 610, one of the Land Records of Frederick County by reference thereto will more fully appear. Containing about eleven acres, three roods and one square perch of land. For the second part, it being the same land which the said William A. Wasley obtained from William Hale and Eli C. Wasley by deed dated 14th day of November 1866 recorded in Liber J. W. C. No. 4 folio 493, out of the Land Records of Frederick County, Beginning for the outlines at a stone at the end of the 3rd line of Lot No 2, and the end of the 2nd line of Lot 3 and running with said 2nd line reverse, North 40 degrees East 45¹/₂ perches to a stone at the end of the first line of lot No 3, then North 31¹/₄ degrees East 32¹/₄ perches to a stone North 63 degrees West 22¹/₁₀₀ perches to the South East side of a twelve foot road then with said road the two following courses and distances, viz. South 23¹/₂ degrees West 28¹/₂ perches South 67¹/₄ degrees West 44¹/₂ perches, then South 43 degrees East 40 perches to place of beginning, containing eleven acres, three roods and six square perches of land. Also the said William A. Wasley further agrees to grant unto the said Catharine C. Hines the use of the above described twelve foot road which was granted unto the said William Wasley by the above described Deed from William Hale and Eli C. Wasley in fee simple.
