The above came standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits, Evidence and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is therefore, this 23rd day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety three by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity and by the authority of said Court, do hereby order and decree that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold and that George W. Hawker and John C. Matter of Frederick County, be and they are hereby appointed trustees to make the said sale, and that the course and manner of their proceedings be as follows, they shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them with a surety, or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of twenty five hundred Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this Decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order, or decree in the premises. They shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notice as they may think proper of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, which terms shall be as follows: One half of the purchase money to be paid in Cash on the day of sale, or on the ratification thereof by the Court, the residue in one year from the date of sale the purchaser or purchasers give
