


No. 6042. Deed

No 2. being part of the deed from P. P. Sigman to Henry Schlosser dated the 14th day of May 1817 for 114 acres being part of a tract of land called "Frankendale" beginning for said lot as hereby witnessed to be conveyed at a stone at the end of the fifth line of 23 1/2 acres deeded by Peter Schlosser and wife to Peter Grosswelder, and with the South line thereof connecting the same North twenty two degrees west thirty two perches, North twenty three and three quarters degrees East thirty six and seven tenths perches to the County road leading to Hamburg, then by and with said road South thirty three and one half degrees East forty four and one half perches to the County road leading to Belleville being at the end of the fourth line of Lot No. 1 - then with the said Lot No. 1 down and with said road leading to Belleville South twenty four and one half degrees west twenty eight and one tenth perches South twenty three and one quarter degrees west eighteen perches to the end of nine and seven tenths perches on the fifth line of the 23 1/2 acres of said tract, and with said line connecting the same North twenty one and one half degrees west fifteen and three tenths perches to the beginning containing nine acres, two roads and fourteen perches of land more or less.
