This Deed made this 1st day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty seven by us Charles Hooper and his wife Mary A. Hooper of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Witnesses that in consideration of Forty Dollars, the said Charles Hooper and his wife Mary A. Hooper, do grant unto George Green of the said County all the following described lot of ground situated in Frederick County aforesaid and being part of a tract of land called Tough Lough, on the Annicole River, or Marys Mountain Run or by its any other name whatever. Beginning for land hereby intended to be conveyed at a large planted stone, standing at the end of the 2nd line in the Deed from Richard Marshall, trustee, to Charles Hooper for 110th 2nd 9th dated April 12th 1862, and running thence south twenty eight perches to a stake, thence east seventeen perches to a pile of stones thence north eleven and a half degrees west thirty two and a half perches to intersect the aforesaid second line thence thence with with it south seventy one degrees west ten and a half perches to the Beginning, containing three acres of land more or less, in fee simple, being part of the same land which the said Charles Hooper obtained from Richard Marshall, by the aforesaid deed for 110th 2nd 9th, and recorded in Liber D. C. S. No. 17, folio 403 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, aforesaid.
