at the request of John Edwards the following Deed was recorded May 25th 1866.

This Deed, made this 25th day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty-six by Charles Hooper and his wife Mary A. Hooper of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, witnesseth, that in consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars, the said Charles Hooper and his wife Mary A. Hooper do grant unto John Edwards of the said County all the following described parcel of land situated in Frederick County aforesaid and being part of a tract of land called "Long Rough" part of a tract called "The Amicable Tract" and part of Mary Mantle's Reg. Beginning for the land hereby intended to be conveyed at the end of 20 ps on the 3rd line in the deed from Richard M. Marshall, Justice, to Charles Hooper dated April 12th 1842 and running thence with the outlines of said deed South 32 ps S 20° E 26 ps South 90^o 3 ps S 68° E 40 ps N 4^o E 162 ps to a pile of stones then leaving the outlines of said deed west 29 ps to the beginning. Containing forty seven (47) acres of land more or less. Being part of the aforesaid deed from Richard M. Marshall Justice, to Charles Hooper and recorded in Liber B. P. 7 folio 403, one of the Land Records of Frederick County in fee simple.
