

No 6042. Quit, at the request of John Edwards the following Deed was recorded May 2^d 1867

This Deed made this first day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty seven, by us Charles Hooper and his wife Mary A. Hooper of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, witnesses that in consideration of two hundred dollars, we the said Charles Hooper, and his wife Mary A. Hooper, do grant unto John Edwards of the said County, all the following described part or parts of tracts of land situated in Frederick County aforesaid, and being part of a tract of land called 'Laugh Bough' or the 'Amicable Swamp' or 'Marys Mountain Swamp', or be it any other name whatever, Beginning for the same hereby intended to be conveyed at the end of 162 perches on the 7th line in the deed from Richard Marshall trustee to Charles Hooper for 110th 2^d 9th dated April 18th 1862 and running thence with said line north four degrees east, forty two perches thence South Eighty five degrees west thirty six perches to the end of the first line in the aforesaid deed, thence with the second line thence south seventy one degrees west nineteen and a half perches to the end of the third line of the deed from Charles Hooper and his wife to George Green dated May 1st 1867, for three acres thence South eleven and a half degrees east, thirty two and a half perches to a heap of stones thence east forty three perches to the beginning containing eleven acres of land, be the same more or less, in fee simple, being part of the Deed from Richard Marshall trustee to Charles Hooper for 110th 2^d 9th dated April 18th 1862, and recorded in Liber B. C. 5th 407 folio 403 one of the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid,
